4 Resolution - AIML passed on 23rd Mar 1940 in its annual session in Lahore.

initially called - Lahore Resolution Auti-Muslim League -> Pakistan Resolution

Resolution stated that "The Muslim majority areas in north-west & north-east should be constituted into independent & soverign Muslim states to solve the constitutional problems of India forever. CSSPM5360

Importance:

By adopting the resolution -> league dinarded for the first time a separate homeland for Indian Muslims -> reason was policeies of congress - Anti-Muslim approach of congress-Ministries.

4 Demand of separate homeland - became slogan of Indian_ Muslims.

2. Muslims got a purpose:

3. Muslem League as -> representative;

La Congress Ministries rule had alienated Muslims who now looked for the league as their only hope. When Muslim League passed the Lahore Resolution demanding a separate Muslim state, the Muslims of Indian subcontinent supported it wholeheartedly.

4. Creation of PakistaniMuslims supported the League in its
aim & objectives - finally Muslim League
& Muslims acheived their goal of
separate State on Aug 14, 2947.

Quaid_e_Azamis Address:-Yenue of session was Minto Park near Badshahi Masjid

Guid-e-Azam Concluded his speech by sayin this, "Himdus & Muslims belong to two different relegious philosophies, social customs, & Literature. They meithed intermany nor inter-dime together, & belonged to two dif civilizations that are based on conflicting ideas & conceptions." He further claimed, "Mussalmans are a nation acc. to any definition of nationhood."

Ly During his speech, he medioned the letter written by Lala Lajpat Rai in 1924 to CR Das in which he medioned that Hindus & Muslims were two separate nations that could never be merged into a single mation. CSSPM5360

Himdus & British Reactions on Labore Resolution:-

Himdus & British were equally hostile to Muslim demand. Hindus called the "Pakistan Demand" anti national British had considered themselves as the architect of unity of India & Indian Rakistan demand threatened this acheivement. However despite the Hindu & British Alarm, the course of Muslim, was set towards Pakistan.
