- Quaid-e-Azam M. Ali Jinnah Muslim League lead & other Muslims of sub-continent demanded separate Muslim state to secure their cultural, social, & relegious rights. After Lahor Resolution, the revolutionary period was starte as the. Two Nation Theory. The core of theory was that Islam & Hinduism are two distinct civilization.

The 1937-40 period was critical in the growth of the Two-Nation Theory.

popposed the idea of Federation, denied that Ind was a single country, & demanded partition into regions as 'Pakistan'.

He said, "India is not a nation, nor a country. It is a Sub-continent of nationalities. Hindus & Muslims-are two major nations.
